LOITERING POLICY

It is the policy of the library to provide a safe and appropriate environment, both within the library building and on library grounds, to facilitate the public's use of the library's services and resources.

Loitering is not allowed in the library's parking areas or grounds, including the front porch of the Main library. For the purposes of this policy, loitering means staying in such an area for more than 15 minutes while not engaged in library activities, such as attending a library program or waiting for a ride after using the library or similar activity.

Persons violating this policy will be handled in accordance with the library's established Behavior Policy.
