DEFINITION:

This volunteer works independently to keep an assigned area of the garden in tip-top shape. Occasionally the gardening team will meet to discuss the big picture aspects of the children's garden and memorial garden. Shifts are one hour, two days a week.

This position is at the Fairmount Library.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain weeding in assigned area of garden.
- Plant, remove, and transplant greenery.
- Suggest plant, flower, tree or other greenery purchases.
- Collaborate with other gardeners to maintain the integrity of the garden.

EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS

- Can work independently without supervision.
- Knowledge of gardening, garden tools and greenery.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIRMENTS

- Complete an application.
- Attend interview and training.
- Pass a criminal background check.
- Work two days a week up to one hour.

PHYSICAL DEMAND FACTORS

Physical activities required of a person in this job are: seeing, hearing, talking, bending, kneeling and stooping for up to one hour.
