PERTAINING TO IMAGES OF CHARLES MARTIN SHAFFER – father of Leola

Charles Martin SHAFFER [ca 1880 – 1921] grew up with his parents George F. [1854-1918] & Addie [1858-1918] in Davenport. Charles was an only child. Charles worked on the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul Railroad as a fireman and later as an engineer on the Maquoketa-Davenport branch of the Milwaukee railroad according to his obituary. Charles died in 1921 in Pasadena, California and was brought back to be buried in Davenport in Oakdale Cemetery in the same lot as his parents, George F. and Addie.

Lillian/Lily Belle MARTIN [1878-1958] was born and grew up in the Louisa County/Muscatine County area with her brother Orville H. MARTIN and her parents Jacob, a wholesale grocer salesman, and Belinda "Belle".

Mrs. Lillian Schafer of California is mentioned in the Muscatine Journal newspaper as visiting her mother in Muscatine on Nov. 6, 1930.

Lilly Belle Shaffer is listed in the California Death Index, 1940-1997 as being born in Iowa on

14 Jan 1878 and dying 7 Jan 1958 in Los Angeles, California
