Sign up on Beanstack

Beanstack is the Library's reading tracking app. It allows you to track your minutes and activities and earn tickets for our grand prize drawings!

1. Go to davenportlibrary.beanstack.com
2. Click on the yellow "Register an Individual or Family" button.
3. Fill in your information. Beanstack allows families to be linked together, so that all family members can be accessed with one login.
4. Once you are registered, you will be taken to your account page. This is where you will log your minutes and activities and track the badges you earn!

- Read/Listen to a book that takes place in a part of the world that you wish to visit

- Read/Listen to a book that takes place in a part of the world that you had never thought of visiting before
- Read/Listen to a book that takes place in a part of the world where you live/lived
- Visit the website of a Library that is not located in the United States
- Read/Listen to a book that takes place outside of this world
- Make a list of three book shops or parks you want to visit around the world
- Read/Listen to a book that is written in a language that you do not speak fluently
- Sit on a bench in a park and write a short story about something you can see or hear from that spot, but the setting is a faraway location
- Visit the Davenport Main Street Library and leave a doodle of a snail on the teen area doodle board
- Visit the Davenport Eastern Avenue Library and leave a doodle of an insect on the teen area doodle board
- Visit the Davenport Fairmount Street Library and leave a doodle of a sea creature on the teen area doodle board
- Sign up for another QC Library’s Summer Reading Challenge
