

GROUNDSKEEPER

Definition

This volunteer works independently to pick up trash on the grounds of the library. May also be asked to pull weeds as needed from mulched areas. Shifts are one hour, two days a week.

This position is at the Main Library.

Examples of Duties

- Pick-up trash around the exterior of the library and parking lot.
- Pull weeds as needed.
- Wear gloves and safety vest while performing tasks.

Eligibility Requirements

- Complete online application.
- Attend any necessary training.
- Pass a criminal and sex offender background check.
- Work one day a week for a minimum of two hours a day.

Knowledge and Skills

- Ability to work independently without supervision.
- Knowledge of safety rules when working near streets and parking lots.

Physical Demands

Physical activities required of a person in this job are: seeing, hearing, talking, standing and walking for up to two hours, able to push a heavy cart, reaching above head, bending, and stooping.

The noise level in this work environment is usually moderately quiet and below 85dBAs.
